

## 2020 - 2021 STUDENT DRESS CODE

### East Baton Rouge Parish School System Dress Code:

- **All uniforms must be neat and clean daily.**
- Navy blue uniform pants, shorts, capris, skirts, and jumpers that are less than 5 inches above the knee.
- No jeans, biking shorts, stretch pants, sweat pants, warm-ups, wind pants or jeggings/leggings are allowed. **No leggings can be worn under skirts or jumpers.**
- Burgundy shirts or blouses with a collar. Turtlenecks are acceptable in the winter. T-shirts (underwear) as outer wear are never acceptable. **Only WHITE T-shirts can be worn under burgundy uniform shirts.**
- Rubber sole shoes or sneakers are preferred. **Shoe colors allowed include: black, white, brown, navy, burgundy, or grey.** Shoes must be laced and tied properly at all times. **Velcro flaps must be securely fastened.** (no ballet slippers, slippers, flip flops, or backless shoes (mules) are allowed.
- Approved uniforms (scout, 4-H, Beta, etc) may be worn on club meeting days.
- **Belts can consist of the following colors ONLY: brown, black, or navy and must be worn on clothing that has belt loops. Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times. Pants must be worn at the natural waistline and not dropped below the waist. No large buckles, studs, or charms should be worn on belts with uniforms.**
- **Navy blue, burgundy and/or white coats, sweaters and sweat shirts** are the requirement and should not display inappropriate advertisement or cartoon characters. **(Students may not wear coats in class all day).** School jackets and sweatshirts **with the school logo** maybe worn in class **ONLY. At no time should students wear any hoods, caps, headbands, bandanas or hats in class except on special days.**
- Girls may not carry purses unless there is a specific need. In these cases, the purse must be kept in their book sacks throughout the day
- Jewelry cannot be worn by boys (earrings, necklaces, wristbands) and girls are only allowed to wear **STUD** earrings or very small hoops (**not larger than a quarter**) due to safety concerns.
- No jewelry, especially chains, rings, bracelets, etc. should be worn to school by boys or girls. This is to prevent theft, damage/breakage or loss of items, as well as safety concerns especially during physical education and other school activities.
- Audubon's Spirit Day is held on designated Friday's. Students may wear spirit t-shirts or sweatshirts with their regular navy uniform bottoms.
- Boys must have neat haircuts.
- No hairstyles should be a classroom and/or campus distraction.
- Girls must wear small navy, white or burgundy bows, barrettes or balls only for hair accessories. No scarves, hats or bandanas. Face paintings, decals, glitter, tattoos (fake or real) etc. are not allowed. **Clear nail polish only.**
- Make-up is inappropriate for elementary students. **Fake fingernails are also unacceptable.** Perfume or cologne should not be brought to school or used during the school day as many students have allergies.

### Free Dress Day Guidelines:

- Shorts and skirts must be within 5" of the knee
- No tank shirts or undershirts as outer garments allowed
- No cutoff or spandex shorts or pants allowed
- No pajamas tops or bottoms allowed
- All students shall be required to wear a belt with pants that have loops and shall not be excessively baggy
- Pants must be worn at the natural waistline. (Pants or shorts that expose a student's underwear are not acceptable)
- **No jeans with holes or tears; no jeggings/leggings are allowed (Jeans should fit appropriately, not too tight or too baggy.)**
- See-through apparel, bare midriffs, bare backs, strapless, or items with spaghetti straps are not allowed
- No sandals, flip flops, house shoes, crocs or other shoes of this nature are allowed
- No t-shirts with profane or obscene language are allowed
- No t-shirts with alcohol, drug or tobacco advertisements printed on them are allowed
- No athletic uniforms (jerseys, padded or unpadded pants) or cheerleading uniforms unless otherwise specified by the administration
- Plus, all other items listed under the EBR Parish Dress Code

### Disciplinary Procedure (Dress code Violations):

The following is approved East Baton Rouge Parish School Systems' disciplinary procedure for students in noncompliance with the mandatory uniform policy:

- **First offense:** parent will receive a dress code violation form that must be signed and returned the following day.
- **Second offense:** telephone call by the principal or designee to the parent/guardian.
- **Third offense:** parent/guardian will be required to attend a conference with the principal or designee.
- **Fourth offense:** 1/2 day suspension with the requirement that the parent/guardian return to school with the student and participate in a conference with the principal or designee prior to the student's return to class.
